This term's spelling rules are based on revision of the year 3 and 4 National Curriculum Wordlist.

The final **bold** word in each list is a random word chosen from the National Curriculum Statutory spelling list for Years 3 & 4.

Children need to learn the spellings based on their spelling group:

Bronze (List 1 = 5 spellings)

Silver (List 1 & 2 = 10 spellings)

Gold (Lists 1,2&3 = 15 spellings)
