Bubble Group Timings

Please remember to arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before your child's drop off or collection time. Next Year

We are waiting for the government guidance to be published on how schools will open to all pupils in September. All we know at the moment is that they want all children to return full time. Whatever the expectations, we will review our risk assessments and set out plans accordingly. These will be communicated to parents at the earliest opportunity.

Free School Meals

If your child is in Year 3 or above and you meet the criteria below, they may be entitled to free school meals. Please check and if you think it applies to you go to: https://www.essex.gov.uk/free-school-meals

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (not Working Tax Credit), with an annual income below £16,190
- Pension Guarantee Credit Income Support
- Pension Guarantee Credit
- Employment and Support Allowance, income related
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act, 1999
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit, with a household income of £7,400 or less (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Year 6: Wednesdays 12:30-12:50pm


If you have a child in more than one year group, you only need to come on one of the times for all your children.

BACK TO SCHOOL TRANSITION STRATEGIES FOR CHILDREN

MAKE CONTACT

With their key worker or support worker

USE A VISUAL TIMETABLE

Start to count down the days

PICTURES

Show pictures of school staff to remind them who they are going to be seeing again

PRACTISE VISITING SCHOOL

Walk down or drive over to visit in advance

DRESS UP FOR SCHOOL AND PLAY ACT

. Get dressed up and play 'going to school'

USE TRANSITIONAL OBJECTS

Can they take something from home to help them feel safe and remember you?

PRACTISE CLEANING HABITS

Practise hand-washing and social distancing with toys

COMMUNICATE ANY CHANGES

Be clear about what is happening to ease any worries

USE OR MAKE UP THERAPEUTIC STORIES

Tell them stories about going back to school
