Here's a reminder of some of the common childhood illnesses and whether a child should be at school or not (taken from NHS advice):

- Coughs & colds – send to school unless child has a high temperature (advice is to give paracetamol and see how they go).
- Conjunctivitis – send to school and advise not to rub or touch eyes. Visit pharmacy for treatment.
- Sickness bug / diarrhoea – return to school 48 hours after last episode.
- Vomiting (after coughing or eating something - singular episode) – send to school if feeling well enough.
